- Hats to British Safety Standards must be worn at all times when mounted, and handling for the ring.
- It is advised that body protectors are worn whilst jumping.
- Please do not muck out horse boxes onto the show field, take your litter home with you or use bins provided.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, owners responsible for removing any mess.
- The judge's decision is final any objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the class with a £25 deposit (deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld).
- No refunds will be given on entries, entries may be transpired at the organisers discretion.
- In the event of adverse weather – we will hold ridden qualifiers in the indoor school with a revised show, starting with Ring 1, IT IS ADVISABLE YOU TELEPHONE TO CHECK TIMING OF CLASSES. If the show is cancelled a new date will be rearranged and pre- entries transferred, refunds on entries will only be given when requests are made in writing prior to the new date and with a deduction for secretarial fees.
- All first and second place competitors in each ring must be available for the Championship in that ring, each Champion and Reserve from the Ring Championship to participate in Supreme Championship when classes conclude.

Qualifiers

Equifest:

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the **16th – 19th August 2012**. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify. **Qualifying classes will have Q / E next to them.**

BSPS Bright Stars;

First, second and third placed equines will qualify, making them eligible to participate in the BSPS Summer Championships. Open to members and non members and qualification cards will be given in the ring. **Qualifying classes will have Q / BS next to them.**

15+ Horse & Pony Events:

To qualify for the 2012 National Championship Show the first, second and third place horse/pony will each receive a Qualification Card. To enter the National Championship Show the rider/handler and horse/pony must register with 15+ Horse & Pony Events within 21 days of the qualifying show date. CLASS 1 LEAD REIN BEST RIDER - riders 8 years and under, lead reins must be attached to the noseband. Ponies 4 yrs old or over not exceeding 128cms. **Q / BS**

CLASS 2 FIRST PONY RIDDEN - Riders 10yrs and under, ponies 4yrs old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable for a child's First Pony off the Lead Rein, cantering in individual shows only. **Q / BS**

CLASS 3 RIDING PONY – Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday, ponies 4yrs old or over not exceeding 148cms. **Q / BS**

CLASS 4 HUNTER PONY – Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday, ponies 4yrs old or over not exceeding 153cms. **Q / BS**

CLASS 5 INTERMEDIATE RIDDEN – Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday, equines 4yrs old or over exceeding 146cms. **Q / BS**

CLASS 6 RIDING HORSE – Riders any age, equines 4yrs old or over and exceeding 148cms. **Q / BS**

CLASS 7 HUNTER – Riders any age, equines 4yrs old or over and exceeding 148cms. **Q / BS**

Championship for 1st and 2nd in classes 1 – 7

Winners to be available for Supreme Championship when all rings are finished.

CLASS 8 RIDDEN PART BRED Open to any part bred equine 4yrs and over. **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 9 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEADING REIN / FIRST RIDDEN Ponies not exceeding 128cm riders 9years & under lead reins must be attached to the noseband. 12 years & under cantering in individual shows only, snaffle bridles. **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 10 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS RIDDEN
Small breeds include Welsh A & B, Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor. **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 11 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN
Large Breeds include New Forest, Fell, Dales, Highland, Connemara, Welsh C & D, **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 12 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS IN HAND
any age, Welsh A & B, Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 13 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS IN HAND
Large Breeds include New Forest, Fell, Dales, Highland, Connemara, Welsh C & D, **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 14 PURE & FOREIGN BREEDS IN HAND Any age or height. **Q 15+**

CLASS 15 RIDDEN COB - for horses 4 years old or over.
To be shown trimmed and hogged. **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 16 RIDDEN COLOURED - Plaited 4 years or over, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 17 RIDDEN COLOURED - Non-Plaited 4 years or over, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. **Q / E / 15+**

CLASS 18 RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE / PONY 15yrs and over **Q / 15+**

CLASS 19 PURE & FOREIGN BREEDS Open to any pure breeds foreign or native to UK excluding M&M **Q / 15+**

CLASS 20 RIDDEN THOROUGHBRED – raced or unraced, will not be ridden by the judge **Q / 15+**

CLASS 21 SHOW PONY / SHOW HUNTER 4 years old or over, Not to exceed 153cm, lead reins permitted **Q / 15+**

Championship for 1st and 2nd in classes 15 - 21

Winners to be available for Supreme Championship when all rings are finished

RING TWO Not before 1pm Judge – H. Lee

CLASS 22 RISING STAR – RIDDEN EQUINES 4 – 7 yrs Open to all types, canter only in individual show.

CLASS 23 NOVICE SHOW HORSE - Open to all types of show horse not to have won an open showing class prior to 2012 show season.

CLASS 24 RIDING CLUB HORSE for horses 4 years old or over, exceeding 14.3hh. To include a small fence. **Q 15+**

CLASS 25 BEST RIDDEN GELDING – to be judged on way of going, manners and individual show, lead reins permitted.

CLASS 26 BEST RIDDEN MARE – to be judged on way of going manners and individual show, lead reins permitted.

CLASS 27 OPEN RIDDEN- Open to mares, stallions and geldings aged 4 years and over. No lead reins.

CLASS 28 NOVICE PONY / RIDER - Open to all pony/ rider combinations not to have won a showing class prior to 2012 show season.

Championship for 1st and 2nd in classes 22 - 28

Winners to be available for Supreme Championship when all rings are finished

RING THREE 10AM START Judge – J. Milburn.

CLASS 29 YOUNGSTOCK – Three years and under, any type, class will be split by yearling and two year olds / three year olds if sufficient entries

CLASS 30 SHOW PONY/ SHOW HUNTER PONY IN HAND Any age not exceeding 153cms (15hh) **Q / 15+**

CLASS 31 IN HAND THOROUGHBRED - raced or unraced, racing injuries and blemishes will be overlooked **Q / 15+**

CLASS 32 OPEN HANDLER - For handlers 17yrs and above, judged on presentation and handling ability, all handlers must wear a riding hat. Stallions / colts welcome.

CLASS 33 VETERAN IN HAND – horses and ponies 15 years and over. **Q / 15+**

CLASS 34 YOUNG HANDLER For handlers 16 years and under, judged on presentation, and handling ability, pony must be suitable height for the handler, all handlers must wear riding hats. No stallions or colts allowed **Q / 15+**

CLASS 35 IN HAND COLOURED (Plaited) any age, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. **Q E / 15+**

CLASS 36 IN HAND COLOURED (Non-Plaited) any age, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. **Q / E / 15+**

Championship for 1st and 2nd in classes 29 - 36

Winners to be available for Supreme Championship when all rings are finished

CLASS 37 LEAD REIN AND TINIES WORKING HUNTER PONY – fences not to exceed 35cms, on or off lead rein, riders 12 years or under.

CLASS 38 VETERAN WORKING HUNTER – fences not to exceed 35cms, equines 15yrs and over.

CLASS 39 BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER – for riders/ equines that have not competed in affiliated working hunter classes max height 45cms.

CLASS 40 M&M WORKING HUNTER PONY – small breeds max height 55cms, large breeds max height 65cms **Q / E**

CLASS 41 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY – max height 60cms

CLASS 42 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE – max height 75cms
